I am directed to convey the approval of Government for  
according permission to open Oxford English school with Primary  
1st Standard in English Medium at Devanahally by the management of

subject to the following conditions:

1. that the management should strictly adhere to the rules  
laid down in the Grant-in-aid Code;
2. that the management should get the approval of the depart-  
ment to the fee structure;
3. that there will be no financial commitment on the part of  
Government at any time in future;
4. that the management should reserve the seats as per  
Government Order No. ED 61 TGI. 79 dated 2-6-1979.
5. that the management should collect only nominal fee from  
the weaker sections of the public.
6. Should deposit stability fund.

If the management does not fulfil the above conditions,  
permission and recognition will be withdrawn without assigning any  
reason and to this effect the Department should obtain an under-  
taking by the management.
